## Yearly Contact Lens Care and Policy

A contact lens fitting and evaluation is required annually to ensure good corneal health and a review of lens fit and vision. A separate fee is charged for this service and is not included in a regular eye exam and to be paid on the day of service unless covered by vision insurance.

The **initial** assessment will range from \$75.00 - \$150.00 depending type of contact lens needed by the patient. After the initial contact lens assessment the yearly fitting and evaluation fee will range between \$35.00 - \$50.00. **Contact lenses must be worn to all follow up appointments.** 

## An initial Contact Lens Assessment includes:

- The Contact Lens Evaluation, fitting, and trial lenses
- A starter lens care kit including solution and case
- Teaching and instructions on insertion, removal, proper care, and use
- Follow up visits for up to a three month period

## The Contact Lens fee does **not** include:

- The medical exam to evaluate ocular health
- Medical visits
- The contact lenses themselves
- A Refraction for an eyeglass prescription

All Contact Lens prescriptions expire one year from the date of the exam. This is a Federal and State law and our office is obligated to adhere to it.

## <u>Refunds:</u>

In the rare event that a patient is unable to wear contact lenses a refund will be given for the cost of any **unopened** boxes of contact lenses for up to 30 days. However, a refund cannot be given for the contact lens assessment since the physician performed the service.
